ABOUT THE

For over a century people from around the world have come to rural Central Kentucky to honor the humble beginnings of our 16th president, Abraham Lincoln. His early life on Kentucky's frontier shaped his character and prepared him to lead the nation through Civil War. The country's first memorial to Lincoln, built with donations from young and old, enshrines the symbolic birthplace cabin.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Community Volunteer Ambassadors (CVAs) at the Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historical Park will work under the mentorship of the Division of Interpretation staff to enhance volunteerism, partnerships, community outreach, interpretation, education, and local youth involvement.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITES

- Work with the mentorship of the Division of Interpretation staff to enhance volunteerism, partnerships, community outreach, interpretation, education, and local youth involvement.
- Work with the park's Volunteer Program Manager to increase volunteerism by recruiting a new cadre of inclusive and diverse volunteers and assist with the daily management of the volunteer program, including: managing the VIP email box, assisting with background investigations, record keeping, onboarding new volunteers, volunteer appreciation events, training,
- Conduct continual community outreach within the park such as include volunteer events and public service days. One of the CVA's main tasks for the year will be with assisting with the Knob Creek Grand Reopening Ceremony

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Currently working on or have obtained at least a 2- year, or more advanced degree in any related field such as history, education, communications, resource management, political science, or any other relatedfield
- · Ability to work independently and with a small work group
- · Ability to work with many different types of people and personalities as well as differently abled populations

- High School diploma or GED required
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Be 18-30 years old (35 years old if you are a veteran)
- Be willing and able to commit to a year of full-time work

HOUSING

ABLI park housing has its own dedicated wi-fi, cable and phone land line; personal workspace will be a dedicated office cubicle at the Birthplace Visitors Center and/or Knob Creek Tavern.
