ABOUT THE

This monument was established by President Barack Obama in January 2017 to preserve and commemorate the Freedom Riders during the Civil Rights Movement, who in 1961, challenged discriminatory laws requiring separation of the races in interstate travel.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Community Volunteer Ambassador (CVA) member will help the park establish and create a volunteer program that will address a wide variety of park needs. The Freedom Riders National Monument was established in 2017 so the CVA will work with on site staff to identify the most important objectives for developing a robust volunteer program. The CVA will gain valuable experience and insight into how new NPS units are established and how to scale up operational capacity.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITES

- Providing interpretive programs and public information for monument to visitors
- Participate in a wide variety of community events in order to promote and recruit volunteers.
- Maintain partnership with the Calhoun County Chamber of Commerce
- Maintain the facility and grounds
