Stewards Individual Placements provides individuals with service and career opportunities to strengthen communities and preserve our natural resources. Stewards, in partnership with the National Park Service, are seeking an intern to serve as Community Volunteer Ambassador.

POSITION DETAILS

- Length: position is 50 weeks, 40 hours/week
- Start Date: Monday, February 7th 2022
- Living Allowance: Baseline allowance of \$500/week*
- AmeriCorps Award: \$6,345 (pre-tax)
- Application Due Date: **12/17/2021**, or Until Filled
- Members will attend a week-long, nationwide, National Early Service Training
- Members will receive Public Land Corps Hiring Authority upon completion

ABOUT THE SITE

At Lava Beds National Monument there are more than 800 caves, Native American rock art sites, historic battlefields and campsites, and a high desert wilderness. The Tule Lake National Monument includes both the the Tule Lake Segregation Center and Camp Tulelake.

POSITION SUMMARY

We are looking for a Community Volunteer Ambassador (CVA) to help expand the volunteer program at Lava Beds National Monument and build a new volunteer program for Tule Lake National Monument. Help us develop new volunteer opportunities and connect with new volunteers at both parks. In the last 2 years 100% of Lava Beds has been burned in wildfires and the site is looking to volunteers to help us restore the park. Tule Lake is on the verge of opening its' first onsite visitor center which opens up many possibilities for new volunteer opportunities.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with managers to design volunteer projects
- Create a database of local volunteer organizations
- Help develop partnerships with community volunteer groups
- Participate in community outreach events
- Develop content for the parks' social media platforms
- Help plan and host national volunteer events within the park such as National Public Lands Day, Earth Day, etc.
- Assist with in-park special events

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Organized, outgoing, and friendly
- Hard worker, self-motivated, and able to work independently
- Good at problem solving
- Education: High School diploma/GED required
- Between the ages of 18-30 years old (35 years old if you are a veteran)
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Submit proof of a Driver's License and undergo a Federal Background Check, upon selection
- It is very likely that all participants will be required to be fully vaccinated to serve in the 2022 CVA Program. At a minimum participants will be required to get tested weekly if they are not vaccinated. Dates for implementing these requirements are not yet determined, but we expect that compliance will be necessary by the end of 2021.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Public speaking experience
- Good communication skills both verbally and in writing
- Experience engaging general public
- Experience with volunteering or volunteers

HOUSING

Park housing will be provided.

*If site is unable to provide housing at no cost, up to \$65/week may be allocated to support rent.
