About the Park Site

The National Parks of Boston consists of three sites: Boston African American National Historic Site, Boston National Historical Park, and Boston Harbor Islands National and State Park. They are located in Boston, the capital and largest city of Massachusetts, which encompasses 21 diverse neighborhoods and is home to more than 685,000 residents.
